CANDIDATE PROFILE	<p>The European School of Paris La Défense in Courbevoie is looking for a qualified teacher of physics and chemistry (eligibility to teach in an EU country is essential), preferably with experience of teaching in a European school or in an international education context.</p> <p>A C2 level in English is required to teach within the English-language section. A B2 level in French is also required to allow you to consult with your non-English speaking colleagues, to meet with your pupils' parents and to help develop cooperation between the two language sections.</p>
SPECIFIC SKILLS REQUIRED	<p>The main required skills are those included in the '<i>référentiel de compétence des métiers du professorat et de l'éducation</i>' (<i>arrêté du 1^{er} juillet 2013 - J.O. du 18 juillet 2013</i>).</p> <p>Particular attention will be given to the following aspects:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Your ability to work in a team, to foster and promote the European School project in a multicultural environment. ▪ Your command of the curriculum of the European Schools regarding integrated sciences for levels S1 and S2, and physical science and chemistry for level S5. ▪ Your capacity to implement innovative teaching methods. ▪ Your mastery of digital tools as applied to teaching in order to foster learning.
